We deliver gas to more than two million customers across every Australian mainland state and the Northern Territory, through 35,000km of distribution networks, 4,300km of gas transmission pipelines and via 60 petajoules of gas storage capacity.

DBP operates Western Australia's principal gas transmission system. Australian Gas Infrastructure Developments (AGID) operates unregulated transmission pipelines, gas processing and storage in Western Australia and the Northern Territory.



AGN operates gas infrastructure (distribution and transmission pipelines) in Victoria, South Australia, Queensland, New South Wales and the Northern Territory and Australia's largest renewable hydrogen production facility, Hydrogen Park South Australia.

We were again ranked in the Top 20 GoodCompany Awards for 2024, in 12th place up from 16th in 2023 - an amazing achievement by our people helping to make a positive impact in our communities.

We are committed to the communities that we serve.

As we enter the fifth year of our Community Partnerships Program (CPP) we continue our commitment to being a socially responsible organisation, actively supporting communities where we operate across the country.

At AGIG we believe that one of the ways we can make a difference is by empowering our people to contribute to causes that matter most to them. In 2024, we saw an unprecedented level of engagement from our team members, with over 120 working days volunteered this year alone. Since 2022, our people have collectively volunteered more than 50 working weeks, making a tangible impact in communities across Australia.

Our Dollar Matching Program also supports our people to make a difference. This year, donations and funds raised were matched at record levels, raising more than \$90,000 – far exceeding our target for the year. To date, this initiative has raised more than \$180,000 for Australian-based charities that are meaningful to our team members.

We are excited to announce that we will soon be releasing our first Community Impact Report, which will highlight the contributions we've made to communities through our CPP, including our team's volunteering efforts and their fundraising endeavours. This report will celebrate the dedication of our people and reflect on the positive change we're helping to make.

As we look ahead, we are committed to continuing our efforts and expanding our impact. We are now welcoming applications for our 2025 Community Partnerships Program, and we invite organisations that align with our Values to apply.

We are proud of all we have achieved and look forward to continuing our connections with the causes that matter most to our people and communities.

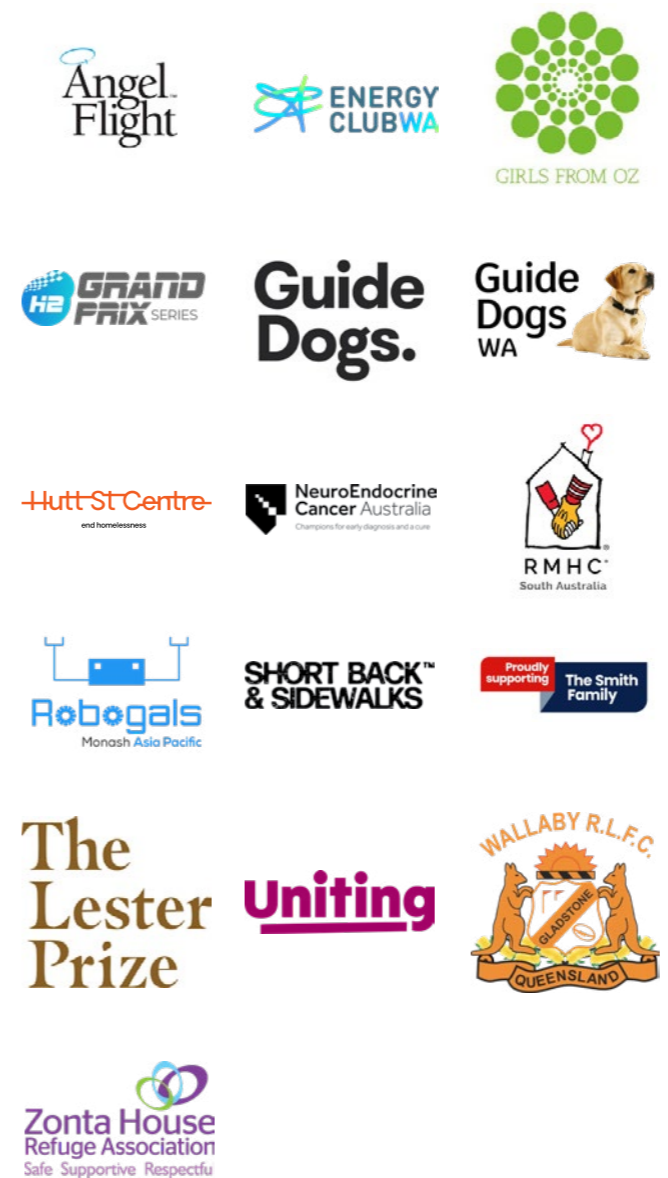

We support our staff to make a difference.

AGIG employees are provided two days paid volunteer leave every year, and in 2024 our staff volunteered more than 900 hours for more than 15 organisations across Australia, including: Cancer Council, Country Fire Association Victoria, Clean Up Australia, Fred's Van, Friends of Warriparinga, Hutt St Centre, Kickstart for Kids, Foodbank, Perth NRM, RSPCA, St Mary's House of Welcome, Sustain – The Australian Food Network, Uniting WA and Zonta House Refuge Association.

Since the introduction of volunteer leave at AGIG our people have together volunteered more than 50 working weeks to charities and not-for-profits across Australia.

Community Partnerships Applications 2025

Applications for funding during the 2025 calendar year are open until 17 January 2025.

Applications should include:

- The organisation’s overview and long term goals
 - A description of specific outcomes to be supported by the sponsorship and how these outcomes will be achieved
 - The defined target audience group and expected reach of the sponsorship
 - The requested contribution from AGIG (financial and/or in-kind) and overview benefits to the organisation, the community and AGIG
 - How the sponsorship will be used, measured and what reporting will occur including key events and dates
 - Any opportunities for AGIG employees to be involved
 - A list of other sponsorships associated with the organisation
- Applicants must be a registered business or charity. Financial commitments will not be paid to recipients via third parties (e.g. via crowd funding platforms).
